


University of Taipei English Certificate of Enrollment



- 1、The 10th Administration Meeting in 2014 Academic Year has approved that the enrollment stamping shall be canceled since the 2015 Academic Year. Existing students shall have “No Need for Enrollment” stickers on their Student ID Cards.
- 2、The student shall apply reissue of Student ID Card if the card is lost.
- 3、According to the regulations of the Ministry of Education, the copies of the two sides of student ID cards are considered Chinese certificate of enrollment. If the student still needs stampings for enrollment, the student may apply by submitting the document glued with the copies of student ID card, **the certification of tuition and fees payment, and the original student ID card.**
- 4、Taiwan High Speed Rail has recognized the University on its website as one that requires no stamping for certificate of enrollment on August 1, 2015.
- 5、The copies of the student ID card shall be glued as follows (Front at the left; back at the right). **The copies shall be valid after stamped by the Office of Academic Affairs.**

Front Copy of Student ID Card
